Amen,

I Isaac Dubose of Columbia County, in the State of Georgia considering the uncertainty of this mortal life and being of sound and perfect mind and memory blessed be almighty God for the same do make and publish this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made that is to say -

First, It is my will that all my estate both real and personal shall remain and be in possession of my beloved wife Sarah Dubose during her natural life, subject to the following disposition after her death

Secondly, I devise give and bequeath to my daughter Martha all my Library of every description for her own use for ever she also possesses of her own two bedsteads, Beds and furniture which she is to dispose of at her own pleasure. I further give and bequeath the heirs of the body of my said daughter Martha four Negroes by the following names and their further issue to wit, Binah, Anthony and Betty (and their further issue are hereby declared to be a part of my Estate and shall be divided among my other children) which negroes are to be and remain in possession of my said daughter Martha, for her use during her natural life. And if she dies without leaving alive heirs of her body then and in that case the said four Negroes Binah, Abner, Anthony and Betty and their further issue are hereby declared to be a part of my Estate and shall be divided among my other children in the same manner as the rest of my Estate.

Thirdly, After the payment of my just debts, all the rest of my Estate both real and Personal, I devise, give and bequeath to the rest of my children namely Clement, Elizabeth, Harriah, David, David and Ann to be equally divided and distributed among them which division and distribution is not to be made until the death of my said wife Sarah Dubose.

Lastly, I do hereby constitute and appoint my beloved wife Dubose my executrix and my trusty friend George Rutledge her attorney to this my last will and testament.

of what kind and nature soever I give and bequeath to my daughter
