Item 2nd I give and devise unto my said daughter Ann E. Lilly
the personal effects to me belonging, such as jewelry, silver plate, books
and furniture or such other goods and chattels as I may die possessed
of and all the following book property both real and personal
described in deed of gift from me to said Ann E. Lilly which
deed is of Record in the Recorder's Office Highland County Ohio
Book No. 11 page 36437 - after first paying Two Hundred Dollars to
the General Assembly's Board of Foreign Missions and One
Hundred to the American Bible Society as a Legacy to each - and of
the Benevolence of Providence said real and personal estate
though be enhanced in Value, said Legacy to be increased at the
discretion of my said daughter. That is to say The remainder
of a tract of land lying in Highland County and State of
Ohio and County 2000 acres or of Entry 3049. made the 11th of
April in the name of J. W. Matthews here - Also the
sum of money paid for good rent in Philadelphia
the 11th of March 1853.

Also Twenty Shares of Bank Stock
of the Ohio Valley Bank of New York
and the sum of money paid for good rent in Philadelphia
the 11th of March 1853.

Charge \$1000 for One Thousand and one hundred and one Dollars - 3^d A single Bill executed by John Beal, Warwick, Batemore and Samuel C. Batemore, to the Executors, and assigned by her Executors to me for Eleven Thousand and one hundred and thirty two Dollars, which if not collected during my lifetime I desire to be paid to Ann C. Lilly. - Also Thirty Eight Shares of Bank in the Pennsylvania W. S. Bank at Philadelphia Item 3^d I devise and bequeath unto my son James Telfair the sum of One Dollar having provided for him what I deem sufficient for his comfort. -

Item 4th I do hereby nominate and appoint my Daughter Ann C. Lilly as Executor of this my last Will and Testament hereby authorizing her to receive all dividends of stock - compromise release & adjust ^{needs & discharge} in such manner as she may deem proper, the debt and claims, due me and that she have full control at my Death of all my effects, and to dispose of the same as seems to her best, without the interference of husband brother or child

I do hereby revoke all former Wills by me made and Testimony whereof I have hereto set my hand and Seal the 16th day of June in the Year 1842. -
