

In the Name of God Amen.

I John Wentworth of the City of Augusta
and State of Georgia being of Sound mind and memory make and
declare my last will and Testament, as follows

1st I desire that my funeral expenses be paid as soon as can be
done out of any of my personal property other than the Slaves.
Hereinafter named

2^d I give the following Slaves, Elizabeth Wanees and Jim and the
house and lot where I reside together with every other house
and lot I own in Augusta, and the whole rest and residue
of my estate whether real or personal, and whenever situated
unto Robert Campbell and James Heaps, of the City and
State aforesaid unto them and their Heirs forever.

I request that my Legates above named, whom I shall appoint
my Executors with if it ever be in their power to do so, man-
cipate said Slaves, which I would now do if I could, and
that for that purpose they present a petition to the Legislature
in the name and at the last request of a faithful soldier
of the revolution, who has no heirs to whom to bequeath his
Slaves, and whom he earnestly wished to reward for long and
faithful service.

Should the Legislature refuse that request, then I entreat my
Legates to do dispose of said Slaves as they may think
will best contribute to their happiness, and that they will
make use of my other property for that purpose.

Should the Legislature grant the request, and allow the
emancipation of said Slaves, I request that the whole
of my other property may be equally divided between
said Slaves and a free man named Robert

and my wish it that under any circumstances, Robt Martin
have one fourth of my estate, after paying debt and settling
the value of said March.

I hereby I nominate and appoint, as my executor, Robert Martin
and James Weaver of the City and State of Georgia
In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and Seal this 10th day of September 1839.
