my Last Will and Testament in manner and form following  
Imprimis I Give and Bequeath unto my eldest son  
Richard Jones Twenty Shillings Sterling to be paid  
in one year after my decease

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Anna Jones  
Ten Shillings Sterling to be paid in one year after my  
decease

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Philippine  
Stanfield Five Shillings Sterling

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Margaret Day  
Five Shillings Sterling

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Son James Jones Five  
Shillings Sterling and apprehending him to be weak  
in his senses and not duly capable to manage the af-  
fairs of this life to advantage Do therefore Will and  
Direct my two sons Jonathan Jones and Nathan Jones  
to take due and proper care of him my sd son James  
Jones and Supply him with food and Raiment he may  
have Real Provision of for the necessary support of life

of the Lands and Estates having after Payments  
when ever the time he can be provided when he dwells  
with them either of them.

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my son John Jones Five  
Shillings Sterling.

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Angan  
Five Shillings Sterling.

Item It is my Will that my Loving Wife Mary shall  
have herself and enjoy the Houses Plantation and  
Improvements wheron I now Dwell during her  
Natural life.

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my two sons Jonathan  
Jones and Nathan Jones their Heirs and Assigns  
for ever all my Plantation Tract and parcel  
of Land wheron I now dwell containing in  
whole Four Hundred Acres being in two Surveyed  
To be Equally Divided between them in Goodness  
and Quality share and share alike reserving the  
Houses and Plantation and Improvements for my  
Loving wife Mary to Dwell on during her natural  
life only I do also Give and Bequeath unto my  
two above named Sons Jonathan & Nathan Jones  
all my Right and claim to one other Tract of Land  
containing one hundred Acres of Land situate in  
the said Acreland adjoining the above mentioned  
tract to be Equally Divided as Directed in the other  
part here and share alike; and it is my Will  
that they my two sons Jonathan & Nathan

as in consideration of all the said Lands now bequeathed  
to them their Heirs and Assigns take due and proper  
care of my son James Jones which he can be provided  
upon to dwelle with them as above directed, also my  
Will is that if either of my sd two sons Jonathan  
and Nathan Jones should die before he arrives at  
Lawfull age then the survivor of them shall have  
posseſſion and Enjoy all the above mentioned plantations  
Tract or parcels of Land

Item All the Residue and Remainder of my Estate of  
whatsoever kind Quality nature or condition etc.  
ever I Give and bequeath to my loving Wife Mary  
to her her Heirs and Assigns forever.

Item I hereby Authorize and Impower my Executor and  
Secretary hereafter named on Receipt of the Money  
due for the same to make Over Convey affre  
and Confirm unto John Coats his Heirs and Assigns  
all that plantation Tract and parcel of Land  
Situate at or near Bush River in South Carolina  
by a Rod or Seats Good and Valid in Law.

Lastly I Nominate Constitute and Appoint my Loving  
friend Daniel Williams Executor and my Loving  
Wife Mary Executrix of this my Last Will and  
Testament hereby Ratifying and Confirming the  
same In witness whereof I have hereunto set my  
Hand and Seal this 18th Day of the 1<sup>st</sup> Month  
One thousand seven hundred and eighty one  
Signed sealed and Acknowledged  
by the said John Jones to be his John Jones <sup>Seal</sup>  
Last Will and Testament in the presence of  
James Jones  
Nathan Jones  
Susanna Jones

Memorandum that on the Twenty-eighth  
Day of January in the Year of Our Lord One  
Thousand Seven hundred and eighty three Before
