surviving me that she shall have hold & possess my  
two wheel Chair with my Horse mare or gelding

for the same, with the whole of my Wearing  
Apparel and ~~Pharmacia~~ <sup>Pharmacia</sup> for her use & benefit  
enjoying her to distribute to my two Negro Wench  
Nan & Phoebe such parts & proportions as she shall  
think proper the same being <sup>unfit</sup> ~~unfit~~ for her use—

Lastly I hereby Nominate constitute & Appoint  
the said Amasa Jackson my sole Executor ratify  
& confirming this as my Last Will & Testament  
& revoking all former Wills or Testaments by me  
made. — In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my

Hand & Seal at Augusta in the County & State aforesaid  
this twenty fifth day of September in the year
