

In the name of God Amen. I  
being of sound mind and memory, do hereby certify that my last will & testament  
is as follows: I give to my son Thomas Martin my negro woman  
Mary, he who was bought & paid for, at the sale of the pro-  
perty of my then late husband Hugh Martin dead, by the  
Jury of the County of Martin & State aforesaid, expressly for  
the said M. Martin, also, I give him my clock, Bureau, Bed  
bedding and mahogany Table

Second. It is my will that my other two negroes Emeline  
and Bob, with the Lot given to John Grady in the City of  
Augusta as his portion of my property in account of his  
wife Adeline (formerly Adeline Martin) be sold at the dis-  
cretion of my Executors (herein after to be named) with all my  
personal property not otherwise disposed of by this will, and  
the proceeds thereof to be equally divided between my son Clem  
Martin, and my daughter Adeline Grady and Martha Pi-  
mon & their legal representatives - Provided, that the said Clem  
Martin and Helen Pimon (the husband of the said Martha)  
shall withdraw at their own expense, the suits or suits they  
have commenced against me for property of the Estate of  
Hugh Martin dead - and provided further, that the amount  
which may fall due to my son Clem Martin shall be placed  
by my Exrs in the hands of a Trustee, to be chosen by them, for  
the sole use of the said Clem Martin during his natural life  
to be paid to him at the discretion of the said Trustee cho-  
sen as aforesaid and the resigners of the said Trustee for  
the purposes specified in this will, but if the said Clem  
Martin should die before the said Legacy should fall to  
him, then the same or his portion is to be divided, shared and  
shared alike between his two sisters Adeline Grady and Mar-  
tha Pimon, as also the residue after his death if any re-  
main. And provided further, that should the said Clem  
Martin and Helen Pimon refuse to withdraw the said suits  
or suits. It is my will that the Executors of this my last will  
seize the same, and appropriate the income thereof after  
paying all expenses for prosecuting the same, and reserving  
for themselves such portion as shall be a proper compen-  
sation for their trouble in the use of Adeline Grady and Mar-  
tha Pimon equally.

sum of \$2000, to be paid to her and her heirs, the sum of  
Twenty Dollars.

Third, I give and bequeath to my son Robert Thomas Bouyer, the  
sum of Twenty Dollars.

Fourth, I give and bequeath to my daughter Abigail Helen Bouyer  
the sum of Twenty Dollars.
