in case of his death before he comes of age and with-
out being living at the time of his death I give and bequeath
the same to my children Ann F Johnson William F Savage
Mary F Savage their heirs and assigns to be equally di-
vided between them

Fourth - I nominate and appoint my friends Herschel
Johnson and Andrew J Miller executors of this my will
In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
this fourth day of September 1839
