and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner
and form following (that is to say)

First I give and bequeath to each of my Executors, to
Mrs Fanny Forsyth to Mrs Sally Armstrong, the daughter
of said Fanny, to Master Robert Mesiah Forsyth & Master
John Forsyth and to Mr William Minor each one part
of mourning.

Second, I give and bequeath to Robert Forsyth
my Interest and Title in and to Two hundred Acres of Land
laying in the County of Wilkes adjoining Lands of Col. Joseph
Pamrell, also my Interest Title and Claim in and to a
Tract of Twelve hundred and fifty Acres of Land laying in
the branches of Sandy run in the County of Washington
which two Tracts of Land are run in his and my name
jointly and which said Lands in the decision of the pro-
perty of Richard Call Robert Forsyth and my self fell
into the hands of said Robert but have never been by me
conveyed unto him.

Third I give and bequeath unto Thomas Cunningham
and William Wallace all that unconveyed part of the
Fifteen thousand Acre Tract of Land laying on the
