Whilst in full possession of my Mental faculties,
Make and declare this to be my last will and
Testament in Manner following, that is to Say

1st
It is my will and desire that all my just debts shall
be fully paid

2nd From the Confidence I have in the Justice and
Rectitude of Thomas Cumming, David Baird
George Biggarth and Henry Croyle, all of the
Said City of Augusta, Merchants, I do devise and
Bequeath unto them, or the majority or Survivors of
Them, and their heirs, All the rest and residue of
My Estates both Real and Personal, of what nature
Kind or description the Same may be, And wheresoever
the Same may be Situate, but upon the following
Terms and Conditions, that is to Say, that the Jus.
And Lawful interest of the Amount of the net proceeds
Of my Estate shall be paid to my Father James Ross
Servant of Botolph Claydon, in the parish of Abbotsworth
of the County of Northampton, England, and to my Mother
Catherine Ross, and to the Survivors of them during the
Joint or Several Lives, And in Case of the death of both,
My Sons herein after Named without lawful issue
Male or Female, I do bequeath All the rest and residue
Of my Estate as aforesaid unto the Survivors of
Said Father and Mother, or to his or her heirs and

After the death of my said Father and Mother
I do devise and bequeath unto my Illegitimate Son
William Murray, born of Mary Den, And to my
Illegitimate Son Alexander Murray, born of Margaret
Scott, both now or late of the parish of Brechin in Scotland
Abovesaid, to be then Divided between them the
heirs and assigns Share and Share alike, And in case
either of them my said Sons, shall die before that
time without lawful issue, the survivor shall
take the whole, him his heirs and assigns, but in
case of lawful issue left by either one or by both of my
said Sons, then the legacy devised to them Fathers
Respectively shall be paid to such lawful issue of
either or either, as the case may be and to be
Enjoyed by him or them and his or their heirs and
assigns forever.

I do give and bequeath unto Mrs. Lotty Cagle
Wife of my friend and partner Henry Cagle the
sum of one hundred dollars, as a testimony of my
gratitude for attention and friendship to me in the
times of my indisposition.

I do devise and give unto my said
friend Henry Cagle, George Megarth and
my daughter, amongst the most particulars, of my
personal effects of my linen and tokens of
friendship, I do devise and give unto my said
friend Henry Cagle, George Megarth and
my daughter, my Silken and Woollen Apparel.

And do request that his said will and testament
 may be duly proved and confirmed by the
 said Judge of Probate and appoint the said
 Thomas Cummings, David Ross, George Rogers
 and Henry Croft, Executors of this my last will
 and testament, and do hereby make all power this
 by me at any time heretofore made
 In Testimony whereof the said Alexander Ross Murray
 have hereunto set my hand and seal at Augusta
 In the State of Georgia aforesaid where no stamp
 paper is had or used, this Sixteenth day of February
 In the Year of our Lord, one thousand Seven hundred
 And Ninety eight
