2^d It is My Will and I do hereby direct and authorize my
Executors to sell and dispose of all the rest and residue of
My Estate real and personal, and wheresoever situated to be
sold and disposed of for Cash or credit, as they may think best
and to collect all My debts, but the Money to be put under
at interest on good security until the Youngest of My Children
herein after named shall come of Age, when the same with the
accumulated interest to be equally divided between Elizabeth
Joseph Day, Simon Day, and Margaret Day, or to the survivors
Survivors of them; but in case they should all die under age, then
it is My Will and desire that the same shall go to and be paid to
any Child or Children that they or either of them may have
in case there should be no such Child or Children, then
give and bequeath the same

3^d and lastly. I do hereby constitute and appoint my
beloved friend James Pearce, John Day and Margaret
Executors of this My last Will and Testament, and I do hereby
give and bequeath the same
