

I Richard C Baldwin of the City of New York do make and publish this my last will and testament hereby making and making void all former wills by me at any time made: And first I direct that what capital and interest may have in the concern of R C Baldwin & Co (at present time) shall remain there until said firm expires by its own constitution provided my executors are satisfied with the arrangements of any copartners, if not, I direct my executors to close and divide said concern as soon as possible and divide my estate in the following manner as soon as it can conveniently be done I give and bequeath to my dearly beloved wife all my household furniture, Library and other household goods which I do possess of together with the use of two thirds of my estate as now or hereafter collected I direct my executors to invest in good stock in the cities of New York & Philadelphia, the income of which shall be paid to my wife annuallly or semi-annuallly during her life time. And at her death I direct such stocks to be sold for cash and divided equally between my brothers and sisters excepting my brother Alvin C Baldwin whose share shall go to his son Benjamin S Baldwin or his heirs. And in case that any my brothers or sisters should die previous to my dear wife then their share shall go to their heirs -

And in case that I should have any children or child then the said two thirds of my estate shall be divided equally when such children or child shall become of age, between them and my dear wife, but the share of my dear wife shall remain in trust as above named during her life time, and at her decease such share shall go to my child or children in equal proportions - I also injoin on my executors and my dear wife to educate such child or children in a manner becoming their capacities -

The other third of my estate I direct to be invested in the same manner as the two thirds and the income to be divided equally between my two sisters annuallly, during their lives and at their decease the said third shall be added to the two thirds to be disposed of in like manner.

I hereby appoint my much beloved brother Alvin C Baldwin

H. Holt and Thomas Taylor, my executors of this my last will and testament.

And witness whereof I Richard C. Baldwin, the testator, this my will, written on one sheet of paper, set my hand and seal this eight day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty
