I then I give and bequeath to my Daughter Abigail Laugh-
-ter Ten Shillings Sterling Money of Georgia to her
and her Heirs or Assigns for ever and that she my said
Daughter Abigail daughtership shall have no more
Estate Real or personal I having given her a sufficient
part of my Estate before
I then I bequeath to my dear & loving Wife Martha Ricketson
during her Natural Life my best & best Furniture
I then I bequeath to my dear and loving wife Martha Ricketson
during her Widowhood or Natural Life the One Third
part of all my Estate Real and Personal and she giving
and disposing of the same not to Embroyle or Waste such part
of the same as she shall see proper

...the said lands and plantation with the premises
whereon I have dwelt to him his Heirs & assigns for ever
Then I give and bequeath to my Grandson Josiah Ricketson
all my other lands within this State as also all my Estate
of Stock, Horses Cattle and Hogs and all manner of Tools
and Utensils for farming together with all my Estate
Real and personal (Reserving the one third part of my
said Estate both Real and personal to be
taken out for the Maintenance of my wife Mar-
tha Ricketson) which said one third part of my
said Estate I ent as abovesaid to my said Wife the
said Josiah Ricketson is to have at my said Wifes
Day of Marriage or Death, To him my said Grandson
his Heirs and Assigns for ever —
