to him George Richards and his heirs.

Item 2. To My Sisters Le. Bissell and Candace
Cattlin of Haverhill, I do give and bequeath
each and Separately the Sum of Ten thousand Dollars

Item 3. To My Nephews Lyman & Catlin of
Augusta I do give and bequeath My
and Grist Mill on Rocky creek, and on the Mill
Road, with Five Hundred acres of Land adjoining
the same, he Selecting the same from any Land
adjoining the mill which may remain my property
at the time of my death. I do further give and
bequeath to him and his heirs the Sum of Ten
thousand Dollars

Item 4. If any Surpluses remain after paying
Debts I do give and bequeath to the
Heirs of Samuel Catlin: Horace Bissell, and George
Richards to each and Separately the Sum of Five
thousand Dollars

Item 5. To My Executors hereafter named and
and in trust Only I do give and bequeath
Thirty One Shares of the Stock of the Insurance
and Trust Company all My Lots on and between
Waller and Watkinson Streets, the Income
which shall be annually invested in Stock or
Executors may sell the same and invest the

Support and maintenance of the said George
during her natural life; the remainder if any
to him George Richards and his heirs.
