River in Georgia granted to me in two tracts of one hundred
Acres each & joining each other both granted dated 5th July 1773
also the following nineteen negroes Major Sarah Kate Penny Joe
Betty Da Chilo. Harry Curry. Capl. Little dick and arew well Jeffery
Ludey toney. Jack. Betty a woman. Henry Frank. - Likewise
one half of all the rest of my moveable Effects. Whither the
same be Horses Cattle Sheep Hogs furniture or other moveable
Property the other half being left to Sam - Likewise one
Half of the Cash I am or may die possessed of Whither the
Property Whither real or personal Estate that I may die
possessed of I desire may be equally divided between my
said two sons and it is my Intention that my whole Estate
be equally shared between them I hereby leave and appo-
int my said sons Samuel & James to be my Executors to this my
last will & Testament and to pay my just debts if any
such there be in writing of all which I do hereby set
