Estate arising out of the sale of my real Estate.

It is my Will and desire that my Son George shall be paid twenty Dollars
the amount for which he holds my obligation.

I give and bequeath to my Wife all my other personal property

I give and bequeath my Silver & Jewellery to my second Son John

I give and bequeath to my other Children some small present at the discretion

of my beloved Wife and my other Executors

I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife all the family Bibles, Books, &c.

and such other devotional Books as she may think proper

to select from the library, and the remaining part of her estate

to be at the discretion of my Executors.

I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife all my Clothing to be divided

among my Children

I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife all my other personal property

and such other personal property as she may think proper

to select from the library, and the remaining part of her estate

to be at the discretion of my Executors.
