men to do and being desirous to settle my outward affaires  
do testify and confirm this to be my last will and Testa-  
ment in manner and form following:-

First of all I sever that my several expenses be discharged  
together with all my just debts.

Item I give and Bequeath to my sons sons namely James  
James Robert and Solomon Vernon all my Land lying in  
the whole 600 Acres 340 thereof being in the tract I now live  
on and 240 more being part of the mill tract so called which  
I was left to me by my Father's Last will which Constitu-  
tes the above Quantity of 600 Acres to be equally divi-  
ded between them Share and Share a like as near in Quan-  
tity as may be Reserving that part to my eldest son Amos  
whereon my Improvement and Building stands to them  
their heirs and assigns for ever.

Item I give and bequeath to my loving wife Content Von  
over all my Movable property of what kind soever  
I be leaving her widowhood keeping only my Desk  
which I give to my daughter Theodore but if my said  
wife should marry after my decease my will is that  
she shall have a good Bed and Bedding and also three  
Good Milch Cows and no more all the remainder I  
give to my above named Daughter and further it  
is my will that if either of my above named sons shal-  
la die before he comes to the age of twenty one years  
that his part be equally divided among the Survivors  
of him or them.

Lastly I make Order constitute and appoint my  
dear friend and neighbor Daniel

of Daniel Williams Esq. of Boston  
do leave to take care of any child or children  
that may be left me in the following manner: That  
to be first applied to the charge of 14 years old boy  
and such to be born before the birth of Daniel Williams  
Middleton at the age of 16 years to learn a trade  
Carpenter and joiner about to Daniel Williams to  
learn his art of wheelmaking and shopJoining at the  
age of 16 years hereby matifying and confirming this  
and no other to be my last will and Testament in writing  
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this  
20th day of the 2nd month in the year one thousand seven  
hundred and eighty two 1782.
