Twelfthly, I leave Sally Hills the daughter
of Ebenezer Hills my negro Wench
Avey, Susanah, Charles and
their children.

Thirteenthly, I leave the Residue of
my Estate unto my Brothers, James
John and William Watts of Liverpool
in England, and which I desire
may be remitted them as soon as
possible ~~and~~ as the nature of the case
will admit together with my
private papers.

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I, ³ before me, Edward White, Clerk
of Probate for the County of Chester
in the State of Georgia, appeared, George
John Hall, one of the Subscribing Witnesses
to the foregoing last Will and Testament
of Joseph Watts deceased, who being
duly sworn by the Holy Evangelists
of Almighty God, saith that he was
present, and did see the said Testator
living, sane, pronounce, and declare
the same to be and contain his last
Will and Testament, and that he was
of sound mind, at the time, to the best
of the deponents belief, and that
Robert Meen and Matthew Eppinger
together with the deponents subscribed
their names as Witnesses at the
request and in the presence of
the said Testator.
