I hereby avail myself of the privilege allowed by the Laws of my County, of disposing of all my Earthly goods, by this my last Will and Testament, to take Effect immediately after my Decease.

First I Give and bequeath my Soul to my God who gave it, my Body by decent interment to its Mother Earth.

Secondly I Give and bequeath unto my beloved Children Major H. Sellers William C. Sellers, Alfred R. Sellers the sum of two Dollars each, and to my Daughter Mary Browning the sum of Twenty five Dollars:-

Thirdly I give and bequeath unto my well beloved Sons William Pinckney Sellers, and DeKalb Cress Sellers the sum of Five Dollars each:-

Fourthly I give and bequeath unto my well beloved Son Raymond Franklin Sellers one tract of Land containing Eight hundred acres more or less being partly in Columbia & partly in Richmond Counties, it being all that I own of a Thousand acre Tract granted to Walton, and also one Negro woman and Slave named Tab or Tally:-

Fifthly I give and bequeath unto my well beloved Daughter Hannah Sellers, provided she is unmarried at my Decease the sum of One hundred Dollars if Married the sum of two Dollars:-

Sixthly I give and bequeath unto my well beloved Sons De Wit Clinton Sellers and Robert Randolph Sellers the place or Tract of Land on which I now live containing Eight hundred acres more or less to be divided by the Mill Branch up to the fork, and thence the North East corner to Walton's line that portion, West of said line

First I Give and bequeath My soul to My God who gave it, My Body by decent interment to its Mother Earth.

Secondly I Give and bequeath unto My beloved Children Major H. Sellers William C. Sellers, Alfred R. Sellers the sum of two Dollars each, and to my Daughter Mary Browning the Sum of Twenty five Dollars:-

Thirdly I give and bequeath unto my well beloved sons William Pinckney Sellers, and Detlieb Cress Sellers the sum of Five Dollars each:-

Fourthly I give and bequeath unto my well beloved Son Raymond Franklin Sellers one tract of Land containing Eight hundred acres more or less being partly in Columbia & partly in Richmond Counties, it being all that I own of a Thousand acre Tract granted to Walton, and also one Negro woman slave named Fats or Fabby:-

Fifthly I give and bequeath unto my well beloved Daughter Hannah Sellers, provided she is unmarried at my Death the sum of One hundred Dollars if Married the Sum of two Dollars:-

Sixthly I give and bequeath unto my well beloved sons De Witt Clinton Sellers and Robert Randolph Sellers the place or Tract of Land on which I now live containing Eight hundred acres more or less to be divided by the Mill Branch up to the fork, and thence the North East prong to Walton's line that portion, West of said line to Robert R. Sellers with one half the Mill ~~land~~ ^{that} portion east of said Branch line, with a half of the Mill to De Witt C. Sellers, and also the Negro Slaves Peter & Henry Pointly between the two. All my other Lands that I may have at my Death to be rented out until my two youngest sons become of Twenty one Years of age, if they or either of them shall live so long, and at that age or their Death if before that time such Lands & the income

to be Equally divided among My Six Children
H. Agnes Phillips, Sarah Anderson, Raymond S.
Sellers, Hannah Sellers, Dewitt Clinton Sellers,
Robert W. Sellers. That is the Land to be sold as
the Law Directs and distributed as above named.
The Land I have given above to My Two Sons Dewitt
& Robert W. after My Decease, to be rented out and
the Negroes, & the Negroes hired & the proceeds of the said
Land & Negroes to be applied to their raising & Education
all the rest or balance of My property of all kinds
saved as soon as may be after My Decease to be sold
by My Executor and after paying My Just debts and the
Legacies herein given to be distributed ~~Equally among the~~
above named Six Children, or their Lawful heirs

Lastly

I do hereby constitute and appoint My trusty
And well beloved Sons ^{My trusty} Philips & Raymond S. Sellers
My true and lawful Executors to carry this My last
Will and Testament into full and complete Effect
