Deal of said State and County being advanced in years and knowing that I must shortly depart this life deem it right and proper both as respects my family and my self that I should make a disposition of the property with which a kind Providence has blessed me so therefore make this my last will and testament hereby revoking all other wills heretofore by me made

Item First

I desire and direct that my Body be buried in a ~~Christian~~ decent and Christian like manner suitable to my Circumstances in life

Item Second

Having heretofore given and Confirmed unto my sons Asberry Deal Minton Deal and Henry Deal and to my Daughters Mary A Parker Mary Seeling and Mosonia Hallis all that portion of my Estate that all and each of them are entitled to or ~~intended~~ I intended them or each of them to have it is my will that they and each of them have no further interest in my Estate and that they ^{have} no further interest in the final distribution of my Estate either they or their representatives other than hereafter provided for

Item Third

I give and bequeath to my son in law - Benjamin Hallis five dollars in Current Money and direct my Executor herein after appointed to pay it from proceeds of my Estate

Item Fourth

I give and bequeath to my friend and Grand Son William D. H. Deal in Trust for my Daughter Martha C. Deal and her Son Augustus C. Deal the entire residue

as herein before provided for as to the

the parties whom he represents

Grand Son William S. H. Beal Executor
of this My last Will and Testament
