deem it right and proper both as respects my family
and my self that I should make a disposition of the
property with which a kind Providence has blessed
me do therefore make this my last will and testament
humbly revoking all other wills heartily made

Item First

I give and direct that my body be buried
in a ~~christian~~ decent and christian like manner
suitable to my circumstances in life

Item Second

Having heartily given and confirmed unto my
sons Asberry Yeale Merton Yeale and Henry
Yeale and to my daughter Maga A Parker
Mary Sciling and Moronia Hallis all that portion
of my estate that all and each of them are intitled
~~to or intended~~ I intend them or each of them
to have it is my will that they and each of them
have no further interest in my estate and that
they ^{have} no further interest in the final distribution
of my estate either they or their representatives
other than hereafter provided for

Item Third

I give and bequeath to my son in law —
Benjamin Hallis five dollars in current money
and direct my Executor herein after appointed
to pay it from proceeds of my estate

Item Fourth

I give and bequeath to my friend and
Grand Son William J. H. Yeale in trust
for my daughter Martha E. Yeale and her
son Augustus L. Yeale the entire residue

of My Estate shear and shear alike which Estate
Consists in Ready Money Notes and Account
and other evidences of debt and all the Stock
of every description Household and Kitchen
furniture and all My real estate wherever
located

Item Fifth

It is My will and desire that all the above
and foregoing described property remain
with and for the use and benefit of My
wife Mary W. Beal during her natural
life and at her death then be divided
as herein before provided for us to the
Trustee may seem best to the interest of
the parties whom she represents.

Item Sixth

I hereby constitute and appoint My
Grand Son William S. Beal Executor
of this My last Will and testament
