

## Gibson B. Reagin Will

I Gibson B. Reagin of said State and County being of advanced age and finding that I must shortly depart this life deem it right and proper both as respects my family and myself that I should make a disposition of the property with which a kind Providence has blessed me with do therefore make this my last will and testament hereby revoking all others heretofore made by me

Item 1<sup>st</sup> I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christian like manner suitable to my circumstances and condition in life my soul I trust shall return to God who gave it

Item 2<sup>nd</sup> I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid by my Executor herein after appointed

Item 3<sup>rd</sup> I give and bequeath and devise to my beloved wife Elizabeth Reagin her lifetime or widowhood with whom I have lived in quietude for many years all of my property owned by me both personal and real Estate and all my ready Cash if any and parts of Land Lots numbers (202) Two hundred and Two the whole Lot excepting the Rightway of the Georgia Rail Road and part of Lot number (203) Two hundred and three all on the North side of a long Branch running across said Lot containing one hundred and forty two acres more or less excepting one square acre in the North East Corner of said Lot and also the North half of Lot number (216) Two hundred and sixteen containing one hundred one and one fourth acres more or less also part of Lot number (175) one hundred and seventy five fifty acres in the North East Corner of said Lot also part of Land Lot number (175) Two hundred and seven all said Lot excepting three fourth of an acre known as the Hammett Grave yard all numbers above

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Item 4<sup>A</sup> { I give bequeath and devise to My wife her lifetime or widowhood part of Land Lot Number (208) Two hundred and Eight in the Sixteenth District of Originally Henry County now Rockdale County Eighty five acres in the South East Corner of Said Lot

Item 5<sup>A</sup> { I give and bequeath and devise to My son Burton Beagin at the expiration of My wife's lifetime or widowhood the South part of Land Lot Number (202) Two hundred and Two in the Sixteenth District of Originally Henry County now Rockdale County bounds as follows to Commence at the East line where the Georgia Rail Road enters said Lot then running up the Right away to the first Cropping above My Orchard then South West to the Public Road then up the Public Road to the Original line in Okechobee County then South to the Original Corner then East to the Original Corner then North to Starting point the Said tract of Land has My dwelling on it containing Ninety acres more or less

Item 6<sup>A</sup> { I give bequeath and devise to My Daughter Mary Beagin and her bodily heirs at the expiration of My wife's lifetime or widowhood the North part of Land Lot Number (202) Two hundred and Two in the Sixteenth District of Originally Henry County now Rockdale County the bounds to Commence at the East line where the Georgia Rail Road enters the said Lot then running up the Right away to the first Cropping above My Orchard then South West to the Public Road then up the Public Road to the Original line in Okechobee County then North to the Original Corner then East to the Original Corner then South to Starting point Containing Ninety acres more or less The Right away of the Georgia Rail Road excepted and should My Daughter Beagin die leaving no living Children then the said Land given and devised by Me unto her is to go and Equally divided amongst My heirs

Item 7<sup>A</sup> { I give bequeath and devise to My son Peter Beagin at the expiration of My wife's lifetime or widowhood the North part of Land Lot Number (206) Two hundred and Sixteen in the Sixteenth District of Originally Henry County now Rockdale County one half said Lot being the North Side Containing one hundred and one and one fourth acres more or less

Item 8<sup>th</sup> I give bequeath and devise to My son John Beagin at the expiration of My wifes lifetime or widowhood the North part of Land Lot Number (203) Two hundred and three in the Sixteenth District of Originally Henry County now Rockdale County bounds as follows Starting at the North West Corner of said Lot running South within Eight Rods of the Center of the Original line then east across said Lot striking Striking the East line Eight Rods north of the Center then North along the Original line to the Corner then west along the line to the original at Starting point Containing Minety Acres More or less Excepting one square acre in the North West Corner of said Lot.

Item 9<sup>th</sup> I give bequeath and devise to My Grand son James W. Beagin at the expiration of My wifes lifetime or widowhood a part of Land Lot number (203) Two hundred and three in the Sixteenth District of Originally Henry County now Rockdale County bounds as follows Starting on the East line Eight Rods north of the Center running West across said Lot striking the west line Eight north of the Center then South to a branch then Eastward up the Branch to the East line then North to Starting point and if My Grand Son James W. Beagin die without lawful Children then the said given and devised unto him by Me is to go and be Equally divided amongst My heirs

Item 10<sup>th</sup> At the expiration of My wifes lifetime or widowhood I give bequeath and devise to My Daughter Phely Goddard and her bodily heirs a part of Land Lot Number (175) one hundred and seventy five in the Sixteenth District of Originally Henry County now Rockdale County bounds as follows Starting at the North East Corner of said Lot running west half across said Lot then South far enough to embrace fifty five acres then west to the Original line then North to Starting Corner

Item 11<sup>th</sup> At the expiration of My wifes lifetime or widowhood I give bequeath and devise to My Daughter Martha Gramade and her bodily heirs that part of Land Lot Number (203) Two hundred and three in the Sixteenth District of Originally Henry County now Rockdale County bounds as follows Starting on the North line Seventy one Rods from the North Corner of said Lot running west to the head of a

Then South West down the Hollow to a Branch just above the old Still house place including one fourth part of one Acre over the Branch oposit the Stillhouse place then down the Branch to the Original line then South along the line to the Original then East on the Original line within seventy one Rods of the South East Corner then North across said Lot to Starting point Containing Eighty Acres More or less

Item 12<sup>th</sup> { At the Expiration of My wife Lifetime or widowhood I give bequeath and devise to My Daughter Matilda Turner and her bodily heirs part of Land Lot Number (207) Two hundred and seven in the Sixteenth District of Originally Henry County Now Rockdale County bounds as follows Starting at North East Corner of said Lot & running Seventy one Rods then South across said Lot striking the South line Seventy one Rods from South East Corner then East to the Original Corner then North to Starting Corner Containing Eighty Acres More or less Excepting three fourths of one acre known as the Hamelton Grave Yard

Item 13<sup>th</sup> { At the Expiration of My wife's lifetime or widowhood I give bequeath and devise to My Daughter Sarah Robinson and her bodily heirs a part of Land Lot Number (205) Two hundred and eight in the Sixteenth District of Originally Henry County Now Rockdale County Bound already surveyed out in the South East Corner of said Lot Containing Eighty five Acres And should My Daughter Sarah Robinson die leaving no living Children then the said land given and devised unto her by me is to go and be Equally divided amongst My heirs

Item 14<sup>th</sup> { I give bequeath and devise to My son Oliver Peagrin five dollars as I have given him a tract of land heretofore

Item 15<sup>th</sup> { And if there should be any effects of My personal property remaining at the Expiration of My wife Elizabeth's lifetime or widowhood it is to go and be Equally divided amongst My heirs

I hereby constitute and appoint My wife Elizabeth  
 Peagin and My son Oliver Peagin Executors of this  
 My last will and Testament  
 This September the 1<sup>st</sup> 1873
