State of Georgia } I, James R. McCallum of said
County of Rockdale } State and County, being in full
health, but of sound, and disposing
mind and memory, and knowing the uncertainty
of life, desire to make disposition of what earthly
goods a kind providence has blessed me with before
I die, which I hereby do in the manner and
form following:

Item 1st I give and bequeath unto my beloved
wife Sarah Jane McCallum, all my property
of every kind and character, both real and
personal, for and during her natural life
or widowhood.

Item 2nd Should my said wife marry, then it
is my will that all my estate, be sold and
the proceeds, be equally divided between my
wife and my daughter Editha E. McLelland.

Item 3rd I hereby appoint my beloved wife
Sarah Jane McCallum executrix to this my
will and testament.

I hereby publish and declare
this instrument to be my last will and testa-
ment, hereby revoking all others by me made.
In witness whereof I the said James R. McCallum
hath hereunto set my hand and affixed my
seal this 22nd day of December 1870 —
