

Book of Wills (A)

State of Georgia } In the name of God - amen
 Rockdale County } I, Jas. P. Wilson of said
 State and County, being
 of sound and disposing mind and memory,
 knowing that I must shortly depart this life,
 deem it right and proper, both as respects
 my family and myself, that I should make
 a disposition of the property, with which a kind
 Providence has blessed me, I do, therefore,
 make this my last will and testament,
 hereby revoking and annulling all others,
 by me heretofore made.

First - I desire and direct that my body
 be buried in a decent and Christianlike man-
 ner, suitable to my circumstances and con-
 dition in life, my soul, I trust, shall return
 to rest with God who gave it, as I hope for
 salvation through the merits and atonement
 of the blessed Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Second - I desire and direct that
 all my just debts be paid, by my Executor,
 hereinafter named and appointed.

Third - I give and bequeath and devise
 to my beloved wife Julia K. Wilson my house
 and lot, situate in the Town of Conyers, on the
 South side of the Ga. R.R., known & distinguished
 by the number two hundred and ninety five,
 containing one-fourth (1/4) acres more or less, with
 all the rights, members and appurtenances to
 said house and lot belonging, during her
 natural life. To her heirs, benefit and
 behoof, during her natural life. I also give
 and bequeath to my beloved wife aforesaid,
 all my personal property, and all the

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the same being in said house at this date, for and during her natural life.

Fourth — I give, bequeath and devise unto my beloved Children Wm. J. Lila & Mary A. Parkerson the house and lot aforesaid after the death of my wife, to their own proper use, benefit and behoof forever, with full power to dispose of the same by will or otherwise, as they may deem proper, without any limitation whatever.

Fifth — I give, bequeath and devise unto my wife aforesaid my bar-room, situate in the Town of Longers, together with all its fixtures, wines, liquors &c and all the rights, members and appurtenances to the same in any way appertaining or belonging, for the support of herself and children, with full power to sell, convey or assign the same for the purpose aforesaid, without any limitation whatever, except as hereinbefore mentioned.

Sixth — I give and bequeath, and devise unto my said wife, for the use of herself and children, and for their support for and during their life, after my burial expenses, Physicians bills and expenses for making this Will are paid, all my money on hand with full power to use, dispose of, and invest the same in any way whatever for the purposes aforesaid —

Seventhly — I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved wife aforesaid, executrix of this my last will and testament.
