said being of sound mind and admonished by extreme old age and the ravages of disease. That the time of my departure is nigh at hand. hereby make by these present a last request. That after I have departed this life and my property notes and affects of which I am seized and possessed which shall have been disposed of and collected.

I hereby request that the first money so collected shall of that sum be taken. Five Hundred dollars. to be expended in enclosing the burial grounds know as the Albert grave yard. If the said sum is sufficient I direct that sixty feet square shall be properly enclosed. If not enough to enclose that large an area then make it a little smaller. That this request may be properly executed. I hereby appoint my sons John Faud William T. Albert. to superintend and direct in the enclosing of said burial ground and that my legal representative shall pay said sum to said John Faud William T. Albert for that purpose. Signed and sealed in the presence

of us this the 11th of July A.D. 1874.
