In the Name of God Amen
I John Churchill of the County of Newton and
State of Georgia being of sound and disposing
Mind and Memory and being desirous to settle my
worldly affairs which I have strength so to do, do make
and publish this my last will and testament

And first I commit my soul to God who gave it
and my body to be buried with Christian Burial
and inventory Estate disposed of as follows.

Item 1st I do will and bequeath to my beloved wife
Frances Churchill all that I possess in this world
to have and hold so long as she shall live

Item 2^d I do will that after the death of my self and my
that my daughter Sarah Adeline Churchill shall have
fifty acres of my land including that part wherein
my house stands and also such household furniture
as she shall at that time claim or affordant the
Kitchen furniture shall all belong to the said Sarah
Adeline and whereas Little Adeline Churchill has
been kind and dutiful to her parents I will that
at the division of my Estate she shall have a cow
and Calf and one years provisions

Item 3rd It is ^{also} my desire that Sarah Adeline Churchill permit
her Sister Neta Caroline Homby to remain in the house
where she now lives as long as she remains unmarried

Item 4th I will that the balance of my Estate not mentioned
above be sold by my Executor and all my debts liquidated
and after all expenses paid I desire the remainder
of the Estate to Equally divided among all my children
except Sarah Adeline Churchill such children as
are indebted to me may receive their indebtedness
as a part of their portion

Item 5th Whereas I have in my possession some articles left
to my Grand Daughter Annie Louisa Lucy left in my
care by her father consisting of one Bed and Bedstead

therewith what may be coming to her from my wife I have in
trust together with the Charge of the Child Lou Sacy to my
Daughter Adeline till Lou Sacy shall come of age or be
Married at which time it shall be turned to the said
Adeline Louisa Sacy.
