Secondly I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid without delay by my Executor hereinafter named and Appointed

Thirdly I give bequeath devise to my Son William S. Albert my entire property both Real and personal of every description it being a Childs part of the Estate of the Estate of my said husband John Albert deceased of Said County and State & my interest in said Estate being one seventh a Childs part all without limitation
