In the name of God amen.

I Robert H Farmer of the County of Newton and State of Georgia being of sound and disposing mind and memory and being desirous of settling my worldly affairs while I have strength to do so do make and publish this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all wills by me at any time before made

and first I command my soul to God who gave it. First I wish my Executor to be paid by my wife Elizabeth Farmer who I hereby appoint as my lawfull Executor of my whole Estate both Real and personal Estate and I hereby authorize my wife as Executor to do and act with my Estate precisely as I myself would do were I personally present in my room as Prophete by keeping the property and family together and managing the family and doing the same as if I were present acting the same. I wish my wife to give my children as they come of age or marry one feather Bed & Furniture & one Cow & Calf each. I also put this authority in my wife as Executrix for and during her widowhood or life and at her death to go to my children and if she marries I will the Estate to my children & wife equally.

In witness whereof I the said Robert H Farmer to this my will have set my hand and Seal this 20th 1864 Robert H Farmer (R.H.)
