Farmer of the County of Newton and State of Georgia being of Sound and disposing mind and memory and being desirous of settling my worldly affairs while I have strength to do so, do make and publish this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all wills by me at any ^{time} ~~times~~ by me made

and first I commend my Soul to God who gave it. Next I wish my ^{dearly} loved to be paid by my wife Elizabeth Farmer who I hereby appoint as my lawfull Executor of my whole Estate both Real and personal Estate and I hereby authorize my wife as Executor to do and act with my Estate precisely as I myself would do were I personally present in my room as proprietor by keeping the property and family together and raising the family and doing the same as if I were present acting the same. I wish my wife to give my Children as they come of age or marry one feather bed & Furniture & one Cow & Calf each. I also put this authority in my wife as Executor for and during her widowhood or life and at her death to go to my Children and if she marry. I will the Estate to my Children & wife Equally
