

Susan White's Will

I Susan White of the County of Rockdale and State of Georgia being of sound and disposing mind and memory and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs while I have strength to do so do make and publish this my last will and testament hereby revoking all wills by me at any time heretofore made and Commit my Soul to God who gave it and desire that my Body shall be buried by the side of my deceased husband in a manner suitable to my Circumstances in life and my worldly Estate I dispose of as follows

Item first I desire that my own and my husband's graves be inclosed in a good and Substantial Manner suitable to our Circumstances in life

Item second

I desire that my Executors hereafter to be named shall pay over to John A Shipley as trustee for my youngest son Charles W. White five hundred Dollars out of my Estate the same to be the individual property of the said Charles W. White whenever he arrives to the age of twenty one years

Item third

I desire my youngest son Charles W. White to have a good feather Bed and Bed clothing sufficient for said featherbed

Item fourth

I will and desire that the residue of my property be equally divided between my Daughter Mary A Sims my Daughter Rebecca W. Harrell my son D. O White and my Grand daughter Corra O Bell but before this division is made I desire that my Daughter Mary A Sims receive three hundred dollars and my Grand daughter Corra O Bell receive three hundred dollars

And My Daughter Rebecca H Stancil Received
Two hundred and fifty for the purpose of making
them Equal with My son D. O. White he having
already Received from Me Three hundred Dollars
And My Daughter Rebecca H Stancil having
Received from Me fifty Dollars

Item Fifth

I will and desire that John S Shipley
Act as Trustee for My son Charles W. White
And My Grand Daughter Corra O Bell
And desire that he take Charge of and
Control their interest in My Estate until
they arrive at the age of twenty one years

Item Sixth

I will and desire that if My Grand
Daughter Corra O Bell Should die before
she arrives at the age of twenty one years
And shall have no Children that her in-
terest in My Estate shall revert to My Chi-
ldren or Grand Children then living

Item Seventh

I hereby appoint John S Shipley as
Executor of this My last will and
Testament

Susan White to this My will Consisting of the fore-
going two and a half pages have set My hand and
Seal this 24th day the 17th 1873
