Rockdale County, In the Name of God Amen

I, Wesley C. Williams of said State and County
being of advanced age and knowing that I must shortly
depart this life deem it right and proper both as respects
My Family and Myself that I Should make a disposition
of the property with which a kind Providence has blessed me
do therefore make this my last will and testament here-

= by invoking all others heart before me

Item 1st I desire and direct that my body be buried in a
decent and Christian like manner suitable to my circum-
stances and condition in life. My soul I trust shall
return to God who gave it in whom I have believed
for many years trusting that I shall realize its happiness
in the world to come

Item 2^d I desire and wish that all my just debts be paid
without delay of whatever character they be by my
Executor or Administrators appointed

Item 3rd My will and desire is that after my death debts
are all paid off that my beloved wife M. P. Williams
have maintain and keep all the balance of my
effects of whatever kind it may be during her
natural life or widowhood and that she give my
two youngest boys (to wit) J. C. & W. K. Williams
one year's schooling to be paid out of my effects
at the death or marriage of my wife M. P. Williams
or even before her death or marriage. My daughter
M. A. Williams or my son W. K. Williams should
either become of legal of legal age or marry my desire
is that my wife give off to either of them what she
can spare & not to give beyond four hundred
and dollars in money and one horse valued
at Eighty Dollars and that she be allowed to
be given to Susannah A. Williams in the event
of her marriage the amount of five hundred

Dollars and Cow & Calf & Bed and also that
be allowed to give of to forego the same or
Account of his Misfortunes in health Seven hundred
Dollars My will is to Distribute the Three Younger
Children first Named (to wit) Susanna A.
J. B. and Th. A. an amount Equal with
the older Children that have Marred off
and left Me. And in the Event that my
wife will Not be able to give the Amount Spec-
ified above to these three named during her
Lifetime or in her bedchamber My desire is that the
amount be made up before any other division
takes place of the amount given as above
Mentioned if these three Children are makeup
Equal with the older Children during my
wife lifetime Then my desire is that all
my effect be sold and an Equal division
be made between all my Children giving my
wife a child's part in the event of her marrying
again to any other man and Should the
Younger Children Not be made Equal that it be
done at her death or marriage and then an
equal division as Specified above begin to each one

Item 4 I heartily Constitute and appoint my Son
John W. Williams Executor of this my last will
and Testament this 26th day of November 1877 {80}
Wesley L. Williams mark
