 Schley County } I Allen Murray of the County & State afore-
 said being of sound & disposing mind & memory, do make
 publish & declare this to be my last will & testament. I commit
 my soul to God who gave it, my body I wish decently buried,
 as to such property as I may be possessed of, I dispose of in
 the following manner, I desire all my just debts paid, and
 after the payment of my debts I give grant and devise all my
 estate both real & personal of whatsoever it may consist, to my
 mother Martha Murray to be had, used & enjoyed by her for &
 during the term of her natural life, and after her death
 then my will wish & desire is, and I hereby give grant &
 devise the same to my two sisters Elizabeth & Sarah Ann Murray
 to be divided equally between them share & share alike.
 I hereby revoke & annul all former wills by me at anytime
 heretofore made and sign seal publish & declare this to be my
 last will & testament. I hereby nominate & appoint my
 friend Mark A. Pearson as my last will & testament,
 signed sealing & attested by me this 30th day of August 1861
 as witnesses in the presence of each other & of the Justices of the Peace
