aforesaid being in firm health of sound and
disposing mind & memory, do make, publish &
declare this to be my last will & testament hereby
revoking all former wills by me at any time
heretofore made. My body I most devoutly commend
my soul I commit to God who gave it, Hoping that
when it shall have left this body that he will take
it home to Heaven to rest as to such property as it has
pleased a Ruler & Providence to make me steward of
I dispose of in the following manner,

Item 1. I desire all my just debts paid

Item 2. Whence I have heretofore given by deed to the wife of
Hollaway Levene a negro woman Ann, and to the
wife of Thomas Levene a negro woman Abby, and
as I desire to put all my children upon an equality
I therefore give grant and devise to Martha W. Myrick
a negro woman named Elsha, I give grant & devise
to Martha Francis Myrick a girl named Lena, I give
grant & devise to Septimus W. Myrick Jr a negro girl
named Louella, I give grant & devise to Nathaniel W.
Myrick a negro girl named Edie. I give grant &
devise to Mary Jane Myrick a negro girl named
Harriet, I give grant & devise to Mr. Thomas Myrick
a negro girl named Emily,

Item 3. I give grant & devise to my wife Catherine Myrick
the lot of land on which I now live, a negro man
named Augustus & his wife Frances & her three children
Emilia, Livinia & Henrietta, and Jerry, also two males
known as Mary & Rhody, also two cows & cats, also two
hens & other fowls, also fifteen shovels, also two best beds
furniture, together with as much of the kitchen
furniture as may be necessary for her use, also as
much of the household furniture as may be necessary
for her use also the clothes & household goods.

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- in this case given, to return to my estate at the death of my wife to be divided between my children
- Item 2) I give grant & devise to each one of my children Septimus W. Marshall Thomas, & Thomas Myrick a leg of the said & same time
- Item 3) As my son Thomas Myrick is small & has not had much of the benefit of an education I therefore give grant & devise to him Three hundred dollars to be used by him in obtaining an education
- Item 4) The rest & residue of my property of any kind & description of which I am possessed of, I desire & direct that it shall be appraised by competent men appointed by the Ordinary and divided equally between my children & share alike,
- Item 5) I hereby nominate & appoint my son Matthew W. Myrick Executor to this my last will & testament hereby revoking and annulling all former wills by me made & signed and published & declare this to be my last will & testament this 15th day of May 1862,
