

In the name of God Amont the Nineteenth day of November one thousand
Eight hundred and four I Anthony Bonnell Senior of the State of Georgia and
County of Scriven Gentleman being very sick and weak in body but perfect in
mind and memory thanks be given unto God therefore calling to mind the
mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die
do make and ordain this my last will and Testament that is to say principally
and first of all I give and bequeath to the hands of God that gave
it and for my body to be buried in a Christianlike
and decent manner at the discretion of my executors Nothing doubting but at
General Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of
God And as Touching such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless
me in this life I give sever and dispose of the same in the following manner
and form Viz first I give and bequeath to my son William Bonnell one
hundred acres of Land on the north side of Beaverdam granted George Harragh

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And also one other tract of Land containing two hundred acres adjoining the aforesaid
tract on the boundaries granted to myself. Also give to my Grand Daughter Elizabeth
Bonnett three hundred acres I also give to my Grandson John Bonnett five acres and
Cultiv and one riding horse And I also give my Grandson Elias Bonnell five shillings
Sterling I also give and desire that the land and plantation wherein I reside at my
death should be to my wife Mary during her life and after her death to be equally
divided Amongst the under named heirs Archibald Mills Henry Bryant Anthony Bon-
nett Thomas F Lovett and William Bonnell I do further give and it is my will that
all my living Lands Negroes money Goods Chattels and Effects both Real and personal
Except the above mentioned legacies Shall be Equally divided Amongst my wife Mary
and Archibald Mills Henry Bryant Anthony Bonnell Thomas F Lovett and
William Bonnell and at my wifes decease I do Request that all her part of said
estate Shall be Equally Divided Amongst Archibald Mills Henry Bryant Anthony
Bonnell Thomas F Lovett and William Bonnell I do also appoint Archibald Mills
and William Bonnell my sole Executors of the my Last will and testament
And I do utterly disallow Revoke and disannul all and every other former
Testamentary wills legacies and Executors by me in any ways before this time named
Willed and Bequeathed Ratifying and Confirming this and no other to be
my last will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
Seal the day and year above written
