In the first place I Will my Sole in the hands
of God him that gave it Secondly as touching the
things of this world which it has pleased God to bless
me with I bequeath that all my perishable property
at my death shall be sold for the purpose of defraying
my just debt and the balance if any to be equally
divided between my children
Thirdly I wish my real property shall be rented
and all my expenses to be paid out for one year at
a time until my eldest child shall arrive at the age
of maturity the profits for the purpose of defraying the
expenses of the education and raising my children which
I wish strictly attended to
Fourth I bequeath that when my eldest child shall
arrive at the age of maturity all property shall be
equally divided between my children my Land excepted
which I wish to continue undivided until the youngest
child shall arrive at the age of maturity then also to be
equally divided between my children as aforesaid
Fifth I Will and bequeath that after my eldest child
