I William Beasley of said County being of advanced age and knowing that I shall depart this life; deem it right for with my Respecter my Family and myself I should make a disposition of a portion of my property which a kind providence has blessed; I do therefore make this my last Will and Testament hereby Revoking all others heretofore made first I leave I desire and direct that my body be in a decent and Christian like manner, discretion of my Executors & friends; second I leave I desire and direct that all debt be paid out of my other property not named in this Will;

Third I leave I desire and direct to be paid to my son Thomas Beasley the place where I live containing seventy five acres; of land or less; purchased from Samuel J. Lockhart the twenty first day of September, 1846; as an estate in fee simple made from said Lockhart;

Fourth I leave I desire and direct to be paid to my son Thomas Beasley Executor to this my Will and Testament.

Signed sealed declared and published by me as per last Will and Testament in the presence of the subscribers who have subscribed our names in the presence of said Testator, at his special Request, on the presence of each other January 7th 1850;
