

In the name of God, Amen: I, Carlton W. West of the County of Dorcon
and State of Georgia, being of sound & disposing mind, memory & understanding,
but labouring under great bodily infirmity, do make this my last Will & Testa-
ment in manner & form as follows; First is my Will & desire that all of my
perishable property, together with my Household & kitchen furniture & all my plantations
& mechanical tools, together with my present crop, be by my Executors here after
named, so soon after my decease as to them shall appear most proper, let & exposed
to sale on a credit of Twelve months with such security as they may think
sufficient & the monies arising from the sales of my property, together with
all the monies due me, both by note's & book accounts to be put to the use
of paying all my Just debts, & if there are any over, it is my will it should
be divided among the Heirs, I shall hereafter mention & if there is not
enough to pay all, it is my will they should all pay his share in proportion
out of the property that I do leave them; Item I give & bequeath to John H.
Smith seventy-five cents; Item I give & bequeath to John W. West twenty-five
cents; Item I give & bequeath to John Mears seventy-five cents; Item I give
and bequeath unto John H. Mitchiner, & Cresamus H. West & William P. Camp-
bell all the rest of my property both real & personal, to wit fifty acres of
land lying in North Carolina on Jackson's branch & twenty-eight acres
in said State on the Waters of King Creek; Item I also give & bequeath
to the said John H. Mitchiner, Cresamus H. West & William P. Campbell

The following names, to-wit: Jeffrey & Jane & Andrew & Ellen and Caroline & her child & Sidney & Sally & child Caroline & Kelly & Harriet and all the Increase that may rise from said negroes hereafter, I hereby make & appoint, William B. Mitchimer, John B. West Executors of this my last Will & Testament, hereby revoking & making void all other wills by me at any time heretofore made & declaring this to be my last & only Will & Testament, and as soon as these my Executors can settle all my just debts then the property to be equally divided among the said John B. Mitchimer son of William B. Mitchimer of the State of Georgia & County of Terceen & Cosmas H. West of the State of South Carolina & Samuel Esq. & William D. Campbell of State of Georgia & County aforesaid each to share & share alike & the said Executors to be Guardian for William D. Campbell until such time as he shall arrive to the age of twenty-one years. In Witness Whereof, I have hereunto set my hand & affix my seal this twentieth day of December in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred & twenty-one. In presence of those whose names hereunto subscribed as Witnesses, signed, sealed & published by the said Carlton B. West, Testator, as & for his last Will & Testament in the presence of us who have hereunto set our names in his presence & in the presence of each other. In the name of God Amen, I William Sheppard of the State of Georgia and County of Terceen, being of sound mind & disposing memory, do make and ordain this my last Will & Testament, in manner & form following: 1st I will that all my debt and funeral charges be paid. 2^d I give & bequeath unto my daughter Sophia Boykin five dollars, also to the issue of her body (if any). One negro girl named Sarah & if she shall die without issue of her body then the said girl to return to my other legal heirs to be legally divided equal among them. 3rd I give & bequeath unto my daughter Martha A. White five dollars, also to the issue of her body (if any). One negro girl named Meriah, and if my said daughter shall die without issue of her body then the said negro to return
