Body yet of sound mind memory and understanding but calling into mind the
morality of all mankind knowing that it is appoivited for them on a to do I do
therfore Constitute and appoint this to be my last will and Testament disannulling
all other wills wherfore made by me and do request this to be Recorded as such therefore
first I Recommand my body to the Earth from whence it came to be buried in a
Christian like manner Secondly I request that all my just debts be paid and touching
such worldly Estates as it hath been please God to bles me with in this life I will
and Bequeath in the following maner to wit First I will and bequeath unto my
dearly beloued wife wingard Bonnell during her widow hood all the tract of Land
whereon I do now live all the plantation tools three head of horses one half of the house
hold furniture my Stock of hogs thirty head of cattle that is to say eight cows and
calves the Remainer in young Stock cattle and four Negroes to wit George Isham
Selby and Harriet and at the expiration of her widowhood do request that the
said property be divided in the following manner to wit all the tract of Land as aforesaid
and the household furniture plantation tools Stock and horses as aforesaid to be
Equally divided between my two Grand sons Thomas Buylor Lovett and the said
kins Lovett and the said Negroes to wit George Isham and Selby then to be
property of the Said Thomas Buylor Lovett and the aforesaid Harriet then to be
the property of Eliza Meriah Sluse and Presamon Sluse Secondly I will and bequeath
unto my grand son Robert Wadkins Lovett three negroes to wit Jacob Nathan
and vice Thirdly I will and bequeath unto them the aforesaid Thomas Buylor
Lovett and Robert Wadkins Lovett one set of mill Irons and one set of mill Stones
which is now on the aforesaid land and all my Stock of Sheep to be Equally

Divided between them & hereby I will and bequeath unto my two Grand
Daughters Eliza - Mariah Hues and Paranomous Hues five negroes to wit Heretofore
I had let deannah and Isaac and ex parte of Land in the twenty fourth district
In Wilkeson County and known in the plan of said district by Number two
hundred and eighty four and all the Remaining part of my Stock of Cattle and
the Remaining part of the household furniture to be Equally divided between them
Fifthly I will and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Lovett one english shilling
Seventh I will and bequeath unto my daughter Martha Hues one english shilling
And I do hereby constitute and appoint Eliza Hues and John Forbes Lovett my
Executors of this my Last will and Testament and trustees for them the Said
Thomas Guyler Lovett Robert Watkins Lovett Eliza Mariah Hues and Paranomous
Hues In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this
twenty fifth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eight
and in the thirty third year of the Independance of the United States of America
