 conferred on me in this life to whom at my death I resign myself
 in hopes of a resurrection to eternal life, my body to be committed
 to the earth, such of my worldly Estate as I may be possessed of after
 payment of my Just Debts & funeral Charges I give & bequeath unto
 Mr. James Platt Senr the sole & full direction & management of all my
 property which I may be possessed of to act as he may think proper
 during the natural life of the said James Platt then & after
 the death of the said James Platt Senr I give & bequeath unto James
 Platt Junr that I had by Mr. James Platt, William that I had by the same

Platt, Jonathan that I had by Mr. James Platt & Charles
 Platt that I had by Mr. James Platt my Children & issue of my body
 each an equal proportion of my Estate to share & share alike In
 case of the death of either then his proportion to be equally divided
 among the survivors share & share alike Signed sealed & delivered
