First of all I give & recommend my soul to the hands of God ~~him~~ who gives it & my Body to the Earth to be buried in a like decent manner at the Discretion of my Executors whom I shall here after name as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me. I dispose of the same in manner and form following that is to say first, of all my desire is Funeral expences and just debts be first paid out of my Estate in the next place I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Sarah Conyers Ten negroes Viz. Joe Kate Nell Solomon to Pence and Manuel also two hundred acres of fine with out old improvement thereon adjoining the place where I now live also one half of all my stock of Cattle Hogs and horses plantation tools having hold counting ^{Scriven Co. Ga. Will Book 2-5 (1808-1829)} fifty dollars due by the Estate of John M. Lucas dec'd. which account I meet in the third place give and bequeath to my daughter Rezinah Conyers also daughter Viz. Abner Lancaster Sarah Little Frank Alex and Florak also two other half of all my stock of Cattle Horses Hogs & such likewise the remaining half of plantation Tools household furniture and moveables Likewise four Tracts of Land Containing in the whole seven hundred & thirty eight acres & half situate in the forks of Orier-Creek & Savannah river, likewise Two hundred acres of fine Land situate in County of Scriven lying on or a cross the Beaver Dam-Creek in fourth & last place I request that Tract of River swamp land containing two hundred Eighty seven & a half acres known by the name of Carthright Originally granted to me the sd. John Conyers Senr. should be sold to pay just debts & other expences attending to my Estate & whatever shall thereafter remain to be Equally divided between my above mentioned Wife & daughter I give & bequeath to my son John Conyers Senr. the sum of fifty dollars to be paid to him by my Executors as his full part of my Estate also I bequeath to heirs of Robert Williamson the like

part also of my Estate, but do hereby Constitute & ordain my
Warranting & Right. W. Miller my Executor to see this my last
Testament fully & faithfully performed in sustaining where I have
signed my name & affixed my seal this thirty first day of the Mas
year of our Lord Eighteen hundred & Eleven the word remain and
