ordain this my last Will & Testament in the manner following
To wit first I recommend my soul to god and into the hands and
protecting Clemency of the Almighty god who gave it and my body
to the dust from whence it came to be buried in decent chris-
tian burial at the discretion of my executors here after named
Second And as touching such worldly estate as it has pleased
god to bless me with in this life I give devise and dispose of
and bequeath the same as follows I give devise and bequeath
unto my beloved son Isaac Congers Two Hundred
Dollars to him and his heirs forever I then I give and bequeath
unto my beloved son Daniel Congers Two Hundred Dollars to
him his heirs for ever I then I give and bequeath unto my
beloved daughter Elizabeth Congers Althins Two Hundred
Dollars to her and her heirs for ever I then I give and bequeath
unto my grandchild John Congers the children of my deceased
son James Congers Fifty Dollars to be equally divided
between them and their heirs for ever I then I give and
bequeath unto my two grandsons John and Jacob Drumm
of Negro girl Elam named Betty and her issue and income
to them their heirs forever I then I give and bequeath unto
my beloved daughter Polly & Congers her heirs forever.
The following named property To wit Polly aged forty year
Peggy Edged thirty years Frank aged fifty years Sarah age
thirteen years Phillip aged six years Mary aged four years
Sybil aged three years and Jane aged four or five months
with their further issue and increase together with all other
Personal Property of which I may be Possessed or intitled
unto to be at his own the said Congers as individual or sole
disposal - This legacy To said daughter Polly & Congers
is subject however to the payment of all the before mentioned
pecuniary legacies and my said Daughter is charged with the
payment of the same and a sufficient portion of my estate
such as she may think proper is to be sold to pay said
legacies if she cannot otherwise raise the money to pay
the same and my said Daughter Polly & Congers is
further charged with the payment of my funeral
expences and just debts due by or to any of my other
children or the residue then remaining of what

... or within it may consist of is that I do hereby bequeath the
 said Polly & Sangers and her heirs forever from and to the
 condition or restriction whatever Lastly I do hereby revoke
 all and every other former and other will and testament by me
 at any time or in any manner here to fore made alluding
 testifying and compassing this and in other to be my last will
 and testament and I do hereby move over constitute and appoint
 my said daughter Polly & Sangers to be sole executrix of this
 my last will and testament in testimony whereof I have here
 unto set my hand and seal the fiftenth day of July in the
 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty five
 and in the sixteenth year of the independence of the united States
 of America signed and sealed and published in presence
 of Rachel Goodall } N B the said Polly & Sangers
 Seaborn Goodall } is to be allowed two years to pay
 all the above mentioned pecuniary
 legacies - The winds and waters and
 her heirs for ever Signed
