mind do certify that this last will and testament after
my funeral expenses and just debts are paid, I desire
that all of my property be kept together until my
youngest child comes of age, except the sum when
last I requested to my son William H Lee, and
my beloved wife Sarah Jane Lee 2nd I bequeath to her
her lifetime twenty nine acres of land bounded by
the Gibbons lands and W & Mariah lands after the decease
of my beloved wife Sarah Jane Lee. I desire all of my
property to be equally divided among all of my children
except Isaac Bonanza Lee who married George H
Mock and is now dead 3rd I bequeath to the said George
H Mock ten dollars as his part of my estate 4th
I bequeath to Lucenia Elizabeth Lee who married
Lion B Mock ten dollars as her part in my estate.
I do appoint Sarah Jane Lee my beloved wife
and William H Lee Executors of my Estate
