my Bed room, Also, all the Books that
-do my Library; and after the death of
said Sister Adeline Gidding as aforesaid,
all the Property in this Item, heretofore
-tioned, It is my will shall go to and

Children of such Children, as may be
if any of my said Sister, as may be
at the time of the death of my said
Except, Eugenia B. Brammer, wife

The said Eugenia Brammer, being

now well provided for I wish for Anne that

or interest in the property mentioned in this
Stem, &c. Should any of my said sister, other
children, her heirs or I will in Anne that
the children of any of said children, dying as a
female, should take their parents share or interest
in the property mentioned in this Stem in
the same way that their parents would have
taken had the said parents been living at
the time of the death of my said sister. And I
further will and desire that all the female chil-
dren of my said sister shall take have and
hold all every interest in this Stem to them
beneath for their sole and separate use
free at all times from the debts contracts
and contrails of my husbands they may now
or hereafter make.

Stem 2d. I Give and Bequeath to my niece
Augusta A. Holdings, the following property to wit
one gold watch, which I now own, one leather
bag, one Mahogany, one Bolster, Two pieces of
one change of cloth. I have to hold
the same free from the debts contracts or contrails
of my husband for her sole and separate use.

Stem 3d. I Give and Bequeath to Mary A. Bennett
the wife of Joseph Bennett of said County the
following Property to wit, Rachel a negro woman
Slave about seven ten years of age (and her child
Sarah, a negro girl slave about two years of age, and
the children of mine now, hereafter mentioned in
the first Stem of this my last Will &c. And I intend
to have said child during her natural life for the
sole and separate use free from the debts contracts or
contrails of my husband and after the death of the said
Mary A. Bennett then the said slave child and
mine and this Stem to go to be divided in Mary
Ellen the daughter of said Mary A. Bennett and the
children of her last mentioned two slaves, should
they be such children, to be divided equally among
all such children of the said Mary A. Bennett as
may be living at the time of her death, except in the
event when any have at the time of her death found
children other than those who are to be in the
event of her death, the children of their parents of their

parent be dead; but should the said Mary & Bernice
depart this life leaving no children or children in
representation of such child or children then it is
my will that the property in this then mentioned as
I well as to the same shall go to Augusta, holding
for the separate use free from the debts contracts or
control of Mr. Washburn;

Then I do hereby appoint my friend Joseph
H. Bernice as the Executor of this my last Will
& Testament;

Then I do shew I die possessed of any property
not herein named in this my last Will & Testament,
I give and bequeath all such property not men-
tioned herein as before said, to my said sister
Adaline Colodney, for the sole and separate use
free from the debts contracts or control of Mr.
Washburn or after Mr. death then to her children
as in the first item of this will mentioned,
with, like exception, as to, Eugenia Brannon,
as appears this tenth day of March in the year
of our Lord Eighteen hundred and fifty four.

in and for said County, Joseph H. Bernice, Exe-
cutor of the last Will & Testament of Delilah Green
late of said County deceased (and producer said Will
& Testament), before me in open Court, and the
Witnesses to said last Will & Testament to wit
Joseph Sander, Singleton, Wijah Roberts, and Rich-
ard Roberts, which, Witnesses being duly sworn
deposed that they saw the said Delilah
Green the Testatrix, sign said last testament and
the Testament in writing now presented as
her last Will & Testament, freely voluntarily &
of her own accord, without, any compulsion
or influence whatever; that at the time of the
executing of said last Will & Testament said
Testatrix was of sound and disposing mind.
