memory do make this my last will and
testament hereby revoking all former
wills by me heretofore made

Item 1st I give and bequeath and
devise unto my son Henry H. Hines for and
during his natural life and after his
death to such child or children as he
may leave free from his debts liabilities
or contracts all that parcel of land situate
in said County of DeKalb containing two
hundred and thirty three acres more
or less the same originally granted to
Edonick Boykin for two hundred and
ten acres and upon which the said
Henry H. Hines now resides

Item 2nd I give and bequeath unto my
son Henry H. Hines for and during his natural
life free from his debt or other liabilities
and after his death to such to such child
or children as he may leave all the residue
of my estate wherein and whatsoever it
may consist

Item 3rd Inasmuch as I have heretofore
given to my grand Daughter Mary Bonds
the half of a tract of land situate in Emory
County etc 349 containing 2000 acres and which
she has already received I consider that as
much of my estate as I can bequeath to her
and herein make no further provision for her

Item 4th Should it at any time during the
lifetime of my son Henry H. Hines and after
my decease be deemed expedient to sell
or change the property herein bequeathed I
hereby authorize my executors in the premises
authorized by law to sell or change the same
provided the proceeds thereof be immediately
reinvested in other property for the use and interest
and subject to the same as the property
herein bequeathed and provided also that
the wife of my son Henry H. Hines shall have
in my estate the use of a home that is to
