Hogg or son in law should come forward they are to have
the above mentioned land I do hereby appoint Charles
McQueen my lawfull Executors of this my last will &
Testament hereby Revoking all former wills by me made

and seal this 21st day of March in the year of our Lord
1826. Signed sealed published and declared by the
above named John Hogg to be his last will and Testam-
ent in the presence of us
