at twelve months credit, That is to say, the Major part of my estate, together with all of my stock of horses Cattle & hogs and sheep & proportioned to have distributed as above. Together with all my Crops of Corn & food except such as I have reserved above. Together with all my plantation Tools Blacksmith Tools, and all my perishable property that shall not be distributed in the above Schedule, except my crop of Cotton which shall be ginned out and carried to market and sold for Cash which shall be towards paying of my Just Debts, and should it not be sufficient to discharge the same then the overplus shall come out of the sale of my Perishable property. Next it is my desire that when the money is collected from the sale of my perishable property that the above legatees which I have mentioned shall be paid. — And the balance of said Money is to be equally divided between my wife Jane Freeman and my children Britton Freeman, Luiza Freeman, and the child my wife is now pregnant with and my son John Freeman, Jacob Freeman, Nancy Mills, Anna Freeman, Thos. Freeman, Chaney Freeman and Mahala Freeman.

15th Next I give and bequeath to my wife Jane Freeman Two hundred acres of land including the Plantation wherein I now live also one acre under and one 16th also I give and bequeath to my son Britton Freeman, Luiza Freeman and the child it now pregnant with, Two hundred acres of land adjoining the land I give to my wife Jane Freeman, Two hundred acres bequeath to John Freeman, Jacob Freeman, Anna Freeman, Thos. Freeman, and Chaney Freeman and Mahala Freeman all the remaining part of my Land to be Equally divided between them all. — Lastly I do appoint Roger McKinney and Jordan Floyd my sole Executor to this my last will and Testament. — In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 15th of August 1815. —
