two shoes and girths, also all of my Carpenters Tools. — 7th. Next
ath to my daughter Nancy Mills, one Negro Girl Kallan at
Cash. — 8th. Next I give and bequeath to my son James Freeman
woman by the name of Jude, also Twenty dollars in Cash. —
and bequeath to my son Thomas Freeman one Negro woman
of Sonney also Twenty dollars in cash. — 11th. Next I give an
Daughter Chany Freeman Two Negroes (Wz) Amy and Sam. —
and bequeath to my daughter Mahala Freeman one Negro Girl
three hundred and fifty dollars in Cash. — 12th. I also give an
Daughter Luiza Freeman one other Negro boy by the name of Dan
13th. In the next place I do appoint all the following prop

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at Twelve months credit, That is to say Two Negroes viz. George and Walter
together with all of my stock of horses Cattle, & hogs and sheep except such
as I have distributed as above. Together with all my Crops of Corn & food
except such as I have reserved above. Together with all my plantation
Tools blacksmith Tools. and all my perishable property that I have not
distributed in the above schedule. except my Crop of Cotton which shall
be gined out and carried to market and sold for Cash which shall
be towards paying of my Just Debts, and should it not be sufficient to discharge
the same then the surplus shall come out of the sale of my Perishable prop-
erty. 14th Sept it is my desire that when the money is collected from the sales of
my perishable property that the above legacies which I have made in
my will shall be paid. And the balance of said money is to be equally
divided between my wife Jane Freeman and my children Briton
Freeman, Leiza Freeman, and the child my wife is now pregnant
with and my son John Freeman, Jacob Freeman, Nancy Mills, Geo.
Freeman, Tho^s Freeman, Chaney Freeman and Mahala Freeman.
15th Sept I give and bequeath to my wife Jane Freeman Two hundred ac-
res of land including the Plantation whereon I now live also one side of said
land and one 16th also I give and bequeath to my son Briton Freeman, Leiza Freeman
and the child is now Pregnant with, Two hundred acres of land adjoining
the land I give to my wife. 16th Sept I give and bequeath to John Free-
man, Jacob Freeman, Chaney Freeman, Tho^s Freeman, and Chaney
Freeman and Mahala Freeman all the remaining part of my Land
to be Equally divided between them all. Lastly, I do appoint Roger
McKinney and Jordan Floyd my soul Executors to this my last will
and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal this 13th of August 1815. —
