Susan, the sum of one hundred dollars each to my grand
son James I Burness son of my daughter Mary
Burness now dead to the heirs at Law of my son
David Corner to the heirs at Law of my son John
Corner and to my son Wilson Corner; each respec-
tively the sum of one dollar to be paid by my
Executors hereinafter named.
- 4) I then I give to my beloved wife Lucretia as a be-
quest and devise for and during her natural life only
All the real and residue of my Estate of whatever nature
and a description it may consist whether real per-
sonal or mixed.
- 5) I then The residue of my property I give to my two
sons Charles Marion and Anthony Lafayette. If then
and the survivor of them should either of them die
without issue and should both die without
children then to my son Wilson Corner.
- 6) I then I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved

wife Lucia Lewis Executor on my worthy Son
Nathan Lewis Executor to this my Last will and
Testament; this twenty third day of October;
