In the Name of God Amen I Francis Sunday of the said State and of the County of Louisa being sick in body but of sound mind and understanding do make and shew this my last will and Testament in manner and form following; That is to say; I desire that all my just debt and funeral charge to be paid and wish to be buried in decent and Christian like manner; and as for the worldly Estate whiche it hath been pleased God to bless me with, I give devise and bequeath the same in the manner following;

First I give devise and bequeath to my son in law Green Scruggs one silver dollar to him his heirs and assigns forever
Item; Secondly; I give devise and bequeath unto my daughter Francis Anderson one silver dollar, to her and her heirs and assigns forever -
Item, Thirdly; I give devise and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Hudson one silver dollar to her and her heirs and assigns forever -
Item; fourthly I give devise and bequeath unto my son in law Richard Scruggs Wiggins one silver dollar to him and his heirs and assigns forever
Item; fifthly; I give devise and bequeath unto Louisa Hudson and the child or children that my daughter Elizabeth Hudson is now pregnant with One Negro Girl named Bess and her future increase to them and their heirs and assigns forever

Item; Sixthly; I give devise and bequeath unto my Grand son Richard Wiggins one Negro Girl named Hagar to him and his heirs and assigns forever, but should the said Richard Wiggins die without a lawful issue it is my desire that the said Negro Girl named Hagar and her increase should be equally divided between my four children; To wit; my son Abraham, Robert, and William, and also Sunday; to them and their Executors Administrators and Assigns forever

Item; Seventhly; I give devise and bequeath unto my four children All and every Article of my said Estate of ale and every kind or nature whatsoever; and I do hereby nominate and appoint Mr James Paul Russell Junr and my son Abraham Sunday to be my Executors to this my last will and Testament, Dated this Tenth day of November in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight hundred & Eleven
