for all men once to die do make and declare this my last will and
Testament; That is to say; Properly and first of all, I give and
commend my soul to Almighty God that gave it and my body
I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a decent Christian burial
at the direction of my Executor; nothing doubting but at the general
resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty Power of
God, and touching such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased
God to bless me with in this life I give devise and dispose of
in the following manner and form—
First, I give and bequeath to Charlotte Clegg my dearly beloved
daughter, a tract of land containing two hundred and forty
Nine acres the place wherein I now reside in the county and
State aforesaid bounded at the time of Survey North by Robert
Dunwoody West by the hill, South by Turner and East by Von-
mack's land Surveyed and laid the 6th 1796 by James Oliver County

Charlotte Clegg above; Secondly; I give and bequeath to Charlotte
my daughter and Benjamin Clegg my slave (one Negro Boy)
Named Cedric purchased from Timothy B. Humphreid of being
according to Bill of Sale dated Soren County February 18th 1808 To the
said Charlotte and Benjamin Clegg jointly after my decease equal
share alike, and the remaining part to be equally divided among
all my children as I herein constitute make and ordain the said
Charlotte my daughter and Benjamin my slave the sole Executor of this
my last will and Testament; and I do hereby utterly disallow remove
lesser and disannul all and every other former testament fully
legating Executor or made by me in any wise before named Date
fixing and Confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testa-
ment. I witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this fourth
day of July in the year one thousand eight hundred and four Andrew Clegg
and Justice Published
as Sored by the said Andrew Clegg to be his Testament and last will
