therefrom to be appropriated to the payment of my debts
and should there be a balance remaining after the
payment of my debts I bequeath the same to Emily
and Anthony ^{children of John C Mc Lain} by
his former wife Elizabeth now deceased.

Item I do hereby appoint and constitute my friend
Ezra Humphreys executor of this my Will and
Testament my true and lawful executor I the said Anthony
Mills hath hereunto subscribed my name and
affixed seal this 9th day of June A D Eighteen hundred
and Sixty Two
